



The Jubilee Gardens Ely were developed by East Cambridgeshire District Council, following broad-based public involvement. The Gardens lie between the River Great Ouse and Broad Street, providing a “green link” from the river via The Park, up to the Porta and Ely Cathedral. They were opened by HRH The Duke of Edinburgh on 11 February 2002 to celebrate the Golden Jubilee year of HM Queen Elizabeth II.
